

Terms and Conditions

Please read these terms and conditions of service in order to understand your duties to Chris Hodgetts and his commitments to you.

The driving tuition is focussed on increasing your driving capabilities on the track. Chris Hodgetts is able to offer:

- Coaching and advice at test days, track days, qualifying sessions and races
- Evaluation of data from data logging systems where available
- Use of in-car video to provide further advice and improvement on all driving capabilities
- Use of specialist equipment such as skid cars, rally cars or race driving school cars where necessary to improve driving
- Contact with racing teams in order to procure test and/or race mechanical support services
- Contact with your mechanic or team on car setup requirements

We will use all reasonable endeavours to improve your performance or race driving skills, taking into account your current level of ability, although we cannot guarantee any outcomes as to level of competence.

Payment

Full payment must be made on or before the day of tuition unless otherwise agreed beforehand.

Cancellation

If you are unable to attend on a day when you have booked our services, the following conditions apply to cancellation by you:

- 14 days or more before – No cancellation fee will be required
- 13 – 8 days before – You will be invoiced for 25% of the day's fees
- 7 – 4 days before – You will be invoiced for 50% of the day's fees
- Less than 4 days before – You will be invoiced for 100% of the day's fees

Your Commitment

Unless otherwise agreed, you will provide your own racecar for testing, track days and race days. The car you provide will be in good mechanical condition and fully fit and safe for use on a race circuit or airfield. If it is a race prepared car, it will fully comply with the appropriate regulations relating to it, contained or referred to within the RACMSA Yearbook.

You will comply with the terms and conditions specified by race circuits and track day organisers and any reasonable instruction from an official of the race circuit or track day organiser.

You acknowledge that we hold no liability for any driving of yours which results in an accident, and therefore you agree to save harmless and keep indemnified Chris Hodgetts, his servants and agents, in respect of all claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death of, or injury to, or loss or damage to property of, yourself.
